

# BOOKING YOUR DRIVING TEST

## HOW TO:



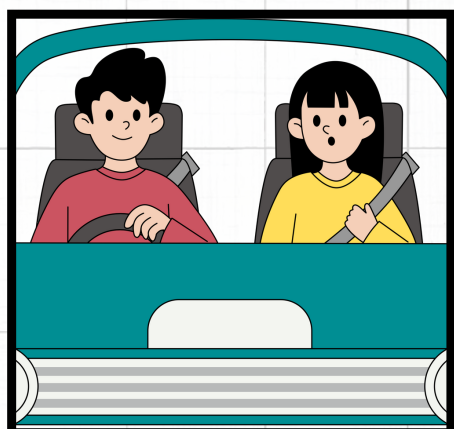
### STEP 1

You must have passed your theory test. You must also hold a provisional drivers license (learners permit).



### STEP 2

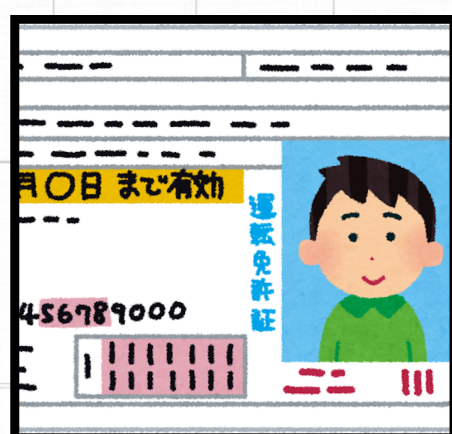
You must have completed at least 12 driving lessons with a certified instructor.



### STEP 3

To apply for your driving test, you will need:

- your learner permit. You'll need to supply your driver number to apply for your driving test. This is the number listed at 4(d) on your learner permit
- your Personal Public Service number (PPSN)
- a valid debit or credit card (Visa or Mastercard) to pay your driving test fee online



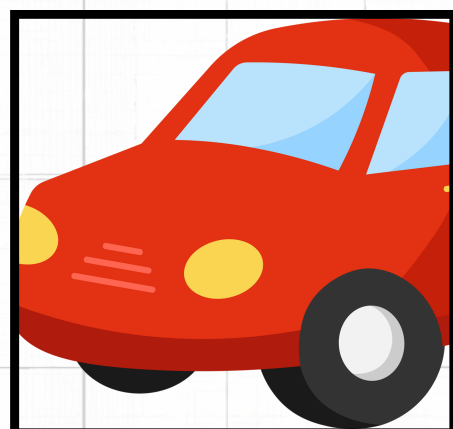
### STEP 4

Once you've successfully logged into [MyRoadSafety.ie](https://MyRoadSafety.ie) you should set your licence goal (e.g. car or motorbike). If there are no suitable dates at your chosen test centre (Tralee) you can try another centre or request to be placed on the waiting list



### STEP 5

You must wait to receive your email invitation to book a test. The RSA estimator will give you an idea of when to expect this, provided you're already on the waiting list.



### STEP 6

Once you receive your booking invitation, you need to log in to [MyRoadSafety.ie](https://MyRoadSafety.ie) to select your test appointment. You have 10 days to select an appointment before the booking invitation expires.
