



YOUNG DRIVER EDUCATION

Last year there was a total of 60 recorded fatalities on our roads by drivers aged 25 or younger. Seven in ten fatal road collisions took place on roads with a speed limit of 80km or greater. Young drivers account for 35% of accidents that happen on Irish roads.



HOW CAN I BE SAFER ON THE ROADS?

- ▶ Avoid looking down at your driving display or mobile phone while driving.
- ▶ Follow Speed Limit.
- ▶ Wear a Seatbelt.
- ▶ Avoid Alcohol and Drugs.
- ▶ Look out for Road Signs.
- ▶ Don't engage in irresponsible driving.

TOP CAUSES FOR YOUNG DRIVER ACCIDENTS

- ▶ **Intoxicated Driving**
Driving with alcohol and drugs in the system.
- ▶ **Distracted Driving**
Drivers attention is taken away from the road.
- ▶ **Reckless Driving**
Driving the car in a dangerous way.
- ▶ **Driver Inexperience**
Don't overestimate driver ability.
